COMMUNITY ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMME 2020

Limerick City and County Council and Limerick Local Community Development Committee (LCDC) invite applications for funding under the Department of Rural and Community Development's Community Enhancement Programme 2020.

On the 22nd June, the then Minister for Rural and Community Development, Mr. Michael Ring TD announced funding of some €2 million for the 2020 Community Enhancement Programme (CEP) with an allocation of €70,118 for Limerick.

The CEP is targeted on enhancing community facilities for individuals and communities that are impacted by disadvantage, in a manner consistent with Limerick's Local Economic and Community Plan (LECP) 2016-2021. It provides support to local community and voluntary groups to deliver small-scale capital projects.

The Community Enhancement Programme was launched for the first time in 2018. In 2019, the CEP supported 53 projects in urban and rural areas across Limerick City and County.

What projects are eligible for funding?

The funding covers capital projects only. Examples include: small-scale renovations to community centres, community amenities, improvements to town parks, common areas and outdoor spaces, development of play / recreation spaces and adaptations or equipment needed as a result of COVID-19.

Limerick's 2020 CEP funding is to be distributed under two measures. It will give priority to projects which engage with Tidy Towns and which focus on bio-diversity, access to outdoor and green space, enhancements to develop outdoor space / amenities and other adaptations that may be needed as a result of COVID-19. The measures are as follows:

- Measure 1 - At least 30% of the funding will be allocated to small scale capital grants of €1,000 or less
- Measure 2 - The balance of the funding will be allocated to capital grants in excess of €1,000 up to €5,000

All applications for funding under this programme will be reviewed and assessed to ensure consistency with the Limerick Local Economic and Community Plan (LECP).

In deciding the final allocations of funding to projects, the LCDC may take account of a number of factors including geographical balance, previous funding received by the applicant and the desirability to fund a variety of projects. The relative disadvantage of the area where the facility is located or the area it serves will form part of the decision process along with cross-reference being made to the HP (Háse Pobal) Deprivation Index.

PART 8 DEVELOPMENT

In accordance with Part XI of the Planning & Development Acts 2000 (as amended) and Part 8, Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), notice is hereby given that Limerick City & County Council proposes to carry out the development described hereunder at the following site at Kilmallock Business Park, Ardyaoul, Bruree Road, Kilmallock Co. Limerick.

The proposed development will consist of

- Development of a Fire Service Training Centre (Phase 1) to include:
 - Change of use from a gymnasium to a Fire Service Training Centre, including lecture rooms, canteen and showering/changing facilities
 - Construction of a fire service drill yard with two drill towers
 - Construction of a Compartment Fire Behaviour Training Unit
 - All associated site works

Limerick City & County Council has carried out an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Screening Report in accordance with the requirements of Article 120(1B)(b)(i) and has determined that there is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment. Accordingly, it has been determined that an EIA is not required in respect of this proposed development. Nonetheless, a person may within 4 weeks from the date of the notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination.

Limerick City & County Council has carried out an Appropriate Assessment (AA) Screening Report and has determined that a full Appropriate Assessment is not required in respect of this proposed development.

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available for inspection and/or for purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy from the 17th July 2020 up to and including the 14th of August 2020 at the Planning and Environmental Services Department, Limerick City & County Council Offices, Dooradoyle, Limerick and Kilmallock Area Office, Aras Mainchin Seoighe, Kilmallock Co. Limerick during public opening times Monday to Friday (excluding bank holidays).
