Galbally Bridge Rehabilitation works

Further to Notice of Significant Further Information published on the 13th November 2025 relating to rehabilitation works on Galbally Bridge at Mooreabbey in Co. Limerick, for clarification, said notice contained a number of errors that require the publication of the below updated notice of Significant Further Information.

Pursuant to the requirements of Section 177AE of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended) and the requirements of the Planning & Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), notice is hereby given that Limerick City and County Council has furnished to **An Coimisiún Pleanála** with significant further information with respect to the rehabilitation works on Galbally Bridge at Mooreabbey in Co. Limerick.
