PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION REGULATION ACT 2009

SECTION 38: PEDESTRIANISATION OF A SECTION OF GLENTWORTH MEWS USING BOLLARDS.

The scheme comprises of the installation of bollards to restrict vehicle access to a section of Glentworth Mews L-10355, creating a pedestrianized area within the laneway.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994, as amended by Section 46 of the Public Transportation Regulation Act 2009, Limerick City and County Council hereby gives notice of its intention to carry out the installation of two bollards and sockets at the following junction:

- Catherine Street/Glentworth Mews

And two bollards and sockets inside the laneway:

- At the turn on Glentworth Mews

These bollards will be in operation 24 hours a day. The bollards will create a safe and pedestrian-friendly zone on the laneway, removing illegal parking on the laneway while still allowing for arranged vehicular access through the council.
