To whom it concerns:

I received a letter today to state that my home Kilbride, Ballincurra Rd, Limerick has been recommended as an addition to the record of Protected structure. We did not ask for this house to be elevated to 'Protected'; We purchased the house in January 2020 and restored it's character internally and externally. We replaced all windows from aluminum to bespoke sash and changed all windows to rear with sash timber. We have restored all shutters and kept them true to their original form. We have worked and had site visits from Tom Cassidy/Conservation Officer who has photographic evidence of change. All planning for new extension sought and approved. I am a little unsettled that if the house becomes 'Protected' does this allow a request from Limerick City and County council to evoke changes at our expense? As this is part of the Draft Limerick Development Plan 2022 - 2028 do we assume that improvements to the structure as complete 2021 can not be included ?
