The development will consist of:

- Segregated cycle lanes and footpath upgrades along the extent of the R510 between Quinn's Cross Roundabout & Raheen Roundabout with dedicated pedestrian and cycle crossing facilities
- Upgrade of the traffic signals at Mungret Gate junction to provide both a protected junction arrangement for cyclists & bus priority measures for public transport.
- 'Front of school' treatment at St. Nessan's National School
- Upgrade works to bus stops, side road junctions, and new road surfacing
- Installation of LED public lighting
- Surface water drainage works
- Landscaping works including tree removal & tree planting
- All associated site works

N21 COOLANORAN TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME**

In accordance with Part XI of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Part 8, Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), notice is hereby given that Limerick City & County Council proposes to carry out improvement works on the N21 in the townlands of Coolanoran, Ardagh, and Ballymorrisheen, Ardagh, Co.
