The proposed works will involve the provision of footpaths, public lighting and positive drainage as required along R521 on either side of the traffic lights. Accommodation works including structural walls maybe required as the land is much lower than the road on Newcastle West side of the traffic lights. This proposal is to provide enhanced safety features on this road for residents within the 50kmph speed limit
