Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Section 38 (3) of the Road Traffic Act 1994, as amended by the Public Transportation Regulation Act, 2009 (Section 46), Limerick City and County Council proposes to introduce traffic calming measures on the L7089 at St Ita's road, Abbeyfeale, Co. Limerick.

A footpath, public lighting upgrades and positive drainage will be provided along St Ita's road to provide safe pedestrian linkage between the retail hub and sports ground in the town centre to the residential area on St Ita's road. The works will involve the upgrading of the existing 600m of footpath commencing at the St Ita's road Super Value and a new 700m footpath to extend to the end of the 50kph zone on the residential St Ita's road. The footpath will facilitate safe walking from Abbeyfeale town centre for this very residential area.
