PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE OF DRAFT DIRECTION IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 31(7) OF THE PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000 (AS AMENDED) BY THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING, LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND HERITAGE TO LIMERICK CITY AND COUNTY COUNCIL AS REGARDS THE MAKING OF THE LIMERICK DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2022-2028

Notice is hereby given that on 28th July 2022, Limerick City and County Council received notification from the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage of his intention to issue a Direction pursuant to Section 31 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended). The Draft Ministerial Direction related to the adoption of the Limerick Development Plan 2022-2028.

The reasons given for the Draft Direction are as follows:

1. The Development Plan includes lands zoned for data centre development located in a non-sequential and peripheral location outside the boundary of the plan for Limerick City, inconsistent with National Planning Framework National Strategic Outcome 1, National Policy Objective 53, National Policy Objective 62 in relation to securing compact and sustainable patterns of development.
2. The Development Plan includes significant lands zoned in a manner inconsistent with National Planning Framework National Policy Objective 57, which seeks to avoid inappropriate development in areas at risk of flooding, having regard to Ministerial Guidelines issued under Section 28 of the Act, The Planning System and Flood Risk Management, Guidelines for Planning Authorities (2009).
3. The Development Plan has not been made in a manner consistent with and has failed to implement the recommendations of the Office of the Planning Regulator under Section 31 AM.
4. The Development Plan fails to set out an overall strategy for the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
5. The Development Plan is not in compliance with the requirements of the Act.

Making a Submission or Observation:

Written submissions or observations in respect of the Draft Direction may be made to the Planning Authority during the consultation period and are hereby invited from members of the public, children, or groups or associations representing the interests of children and other interested parties. These submissions or observations shall be included in the Chief Executive's Report and shall be taken into consideration by the Office of the Planning Regulator before it makes a recommendation to the Minister on the matter. All submissions or observations must be received no later than 19th August at 5pm. Late submissions will not be accepted.

PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT ACTS 2000 (AS AMENDED) PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS 2001 (AS AMENDED) PART 8 DEVELOPMENT

In accordance with Part XI of the Planning and Development Acts 2000 (as amended) and Part 8, Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), notice is hereby given that the Active Travel Department of Limerick City & County Council proposes to carry out the following development works from TUS Moylish Campus to the City on Cratloe Road, Sexton Street North, High Road, Belfield Court and Belfield Gardens.

The development works will consist of:

- Segregated cycle lanes and footpath upgrades along Cratloe Road, Sexton Street North and High Road with a number of dedicated pedestrian and cycle crossing facilities
- Upgrade of the traffic signals and junction layout at Hassett's Cross, Cross Road and Belfield Court Junctions to provide a protected junction arrangement for cyclists & bus priority measures for public transport.
- An inbound bus lane extending along Cratloe Road from Moylish Roundabout to Hassett's Cross and build out with cycle by-pass
- Traffic calming measures on Belfield Court and Belfield Gardens such as raised table junctions
- Upgrade works to bus stops, side road junctions, and new road surfacing
- Installation of LED public lighting
- Surface water drainage works
- Landscaping works including tree removal & tree planting
- All associated site works

Limerick City & County Council has carried out an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Screening Report in accordance with the Roads Act 1993 (S.I. No 14 of 1993) as amended and has determined that there is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment. Accordingly, it has been determined that EIA is not required in respect of this proposed development. Nonetheless, a person may within 4 weeks from the date of the notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination. Such a submission should be addressed to the Secretary, An Bord Pleanála, 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin 1.

Limerick City & County Council has carried out an Appropriate Assessment (AA) Screening Report and has determined that a full Appropriate Assessment is not required in respect of this proposed development.

Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available for inspection or purchase at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy from Wednesday 3rd August 2022 up to and including **Wednesday 31st August 2022** at the Customer Services Desk, Limerick City & County Council, Merchant's Quay, Limerick between 9a.m. - 5p.m. Monday to Friday (excluding Bank Holidays) and at the Planning, Environment and Place Making Department, Limerick City & County Council Offices, Dooradoyle Road, Limerick V94 WV78 between 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. Plans and particulars of the proposed development will be available for inspection online during the above timeframes at <https://mypoint.limerick.ie>.
