PUBLIC NOTICE OPTIONS PUBLIC PARTICIPATION DAY

As part of the development of a viable Flood Relief Scheme for Castleconnell, Co. Limerick, Limerick City & County Council, in conjunction with the Office of Public Works and the appointed environmental and engineering consultants JBA Consulting and JB Barry & partners, wish to invite members of the public, local businesses and organisations to attend a **Public Participation Day**. This will provide an opportunity to have an input to the potential solutions that are currently being considered for the proposed Flood Relief Scheme.

The scheme is currently in the **options appraisal phase**. The project team have considered a long list of potential flood management measures, from which a number of scheme options have been brought forward for assessment. The purpose of the **Public Participation Day** is to give interested parties an overview of these options and provide an opportunity to engage with the project team, share their thoughts on the options and any potential constraints to these options.

The event will take place in the **Castle Oaks House Hotel, Castleconnell, Co. Limerick, V94 EH94 on Wednesday 21st September 2022**. Drop in any time from **4:00pm to 8:00pm**. Presentations from the project team will be at 5:00pm and 7:00pm.

PUBLIC NOTICE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1994 (SECTION 38) AS AMENDED BY THE PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION REGULATION ACT, 2009 (SECTION 46) PROPOSED WORKS R-445 NORTHERN RING ROAD (BROOKVILLE AVENUE), LIMERICK CITY

Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to Section 38 (3) of the Road Traffic Act 1994, as amended by the Public Transportation Regulation Act, 2009 (Section 46), Limerick City & County Council hereby gives notice of its intention to introduce the following road amendments on R-445 Northern Ring Road (Brookville Avenue), Limerick City and the Junction of R-857 Erinis Road and R445 Brookville Avenue, Limerick City:

- Install new raised pedestrian crossing on R-445 Northern Ring Road and L-10512 Brookville Avenue.
- Install lane separators for cyclists segregation
- Install new road markings
- Install new tactile paving
- Install table top ramps
- Install new footpath and drop kerbs
- Junction improvements at junction of L-10516 New Link Road and R-445 Northern Ring Road (Brookville Avenue), the junction of L-10486 Meadow Springs and R-445 Northern Ring Road (Brookville Avenue) and the junction of R-857 Erinis Road and R445 Brookville Avenue, Limerick City.

NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF A DRAFT LIMERICK CITY AND ENVIRONS GREEN AND BLUE INFRASTRUCTURE STRATEGY

Notice is hereby given of the Limerick City and County Council Draft Limerick City and Environs Green and Blue Infrastructure Strategy.

The Draft Strategy has been prepared to build on and assist the delivery of our ambitious vision for Limerick, set out in the newly adopted Development Plan, to create a Green City Region on the Shannon Estuary connected through people and places. The aim is to inform and guide the development of green and blue spaces, including our rivers, parks and open green spaces, to enhance access for all, while protecting the value of our natural heritage and biodiversity.

The Draft Strategy sets out a number of objectives and projects that can be delivered in partnership with local people, community groups and businesses. As part of this consultation process we would value your input and ideas on the Draft Strategy and how it can respond to climate change by promoting the greening of our City, create new spaces for people to play and visit, and to enhance and protect biodiversity.

ROADS ACT 1993 ROAD REGULATIONS 1994- ARTICLE 12 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS – THE CUT TOWARDS BOHER L-50962

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with the provisions of the Roads Act 1993 of the decision of Limerick City and County Council to close the roads as detailed hereunder at the specified locations and times to facilitate Road Drainage Works. Road may be closed for up to 5 days at any time during the period detailed below.

L-50962 (The Cut towards Boher) from its junction with the N24 to its junction with the L-5096	Traffic diverted via the N24 / R513 / L5096 (via Beary's Cross)	From 08:00hrs to 18:00hrs Each day For a period of up to 5 days between Wednesday 21st September 2022 And Wednesday 30th November 2022

- Diversions will be clearly signposted
- Local Traffic will be accommodated if possible

LIMERICK CITY AND COUNTY COUNCIL ATTENTION ALL FARMERS AND AGRICULTURAL CONTRACTORS

Under the European Union (Good Agricultural Practice for Protection of Waters) Regulations 2022 (as amended) you should be aware of the following:

- **SLURRY** shall not be landspread between 08 October 2022 and 15 January 2023.
- **CHEMICAL FERTILIZERS** shall not be applied between 15 September 2022 and 29 January 2023.
- **SOLID WATER** shall not be spread between 21 - 31 December 2022 for all milk producers.

Please Note some important upcoming changes and timelines:

- Storage Capacity for "Solid Water" requirement
- From 01 December 2023 - a minimum of three weeks storage capacity
- From 01 December 2024 - a minimum of four weeks storage capacity
- Exception is for winter/ liquid milk producers where the four weeks storage capacity must be in place by 01 December 2025.

Use of LESS (Low Emission Slurry Spreading) equipment:

- **LESS** (Low Emission Slurry Spreading) equipment must be used for the application of slurry on holdings with stocking rates of 170kgN/ha (or above) from grazing livestock manure prior to export of livestock manure from the holding (this rule is currently in effect).
- **LESS** (Low Emission Slurry Spreading) equipment must be used for the application of slurry on holdings with stocking rates of 150kgN/ha or above from grazing livestock manure prior to export of livestock manure from the holding from **January 1 2023**

Remember

- When spreading slurry and other farm effluents ensure:
 - No heavy rainfall forecast within 48 hours
 - Land is not waterlogged
 - Ensure adequate buffer zones are maintained along all waters including surface waters, water extraction points, lakes, etc.
- Ensure that all operators are aware of their responsibilities
- **Derogation Farmers:** - At least 50% of slurry shall be applied by 15th June.

NOTE: You are advised that slurry and farm effluents should be applied earlier in the growing season for optimum nutrient uptake and reduced risk to waters and atmosphere.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994, as amended by Section 46 of the Public Transportation Regulation Act 2009, Limerick City and County Council hereby gives notice of its proposed introduction of a Pedestrian Crossing on the Rathkeale Industrial estate road.

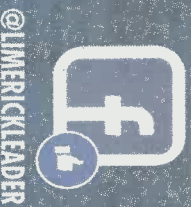
