Hi [REDACTED]. Ger Mitchell and I wish to make a submission regarding the Caherconlish Local Area Plan. We have met with residents on the R513 that were opposed to the proposed walkway that would connect Caherline GAA Pitch and the Millenium Centre. The concerns are that the proposed walkway would de-value the affected houses as it would separate and run through the backs of their houses. There are also privacy issues and the possibility that the proposed walkway would lead to anti-social behaviour and litter issues. Concerns have been expressed about the need for two pedestrian crosses on the Old Barrack Road, and the associated safety aspects. It is also outside the Local Area Plan. The residents believe that the existing footpath routes that surrounds Caherconlish are sufficient and that the people of Caherconlish would be better served from a footpath along the Old Barrack Road connecting the GAA Pitch and the town.
