**MUNGRET LOCAL INFRASTRUCTURE HOUSING ACTIVATION FUND (LIHAF) DELIVERY STAGE 2**

In accordance with Part XI of the Planning & Development Acts 2000 (as amended) and Part 8, Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), notice is hereby given that Limerick City and County Council proposes to carry out the following development:-  
Construction of a new 1700-metre length of road with verges, footpaths, cycleway, on-street parking, public lighting and associated services at the townlands of Baunadoka, Dromdarrig, Caheranardris, and Moneteen, Mungret Co. Limerick.

The proposed development comprises:-

- Surface water drainage / sustainable urban drainage
- Foul water drainage connection into Limerick Main Drainage Scheme
- Watermains
- Telecommunications and utility services
- Roads, footpaths, cycleway, street lighting and landscaping

Limerick City & County Council has carried out an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Screening Report in accordance with the requirements of Article 120(1B)(ii) and has determined that there is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment. Accordingly, it has been determined that EIA is not required in respect of this proposed development. Nonetheless, a person may within 4 weeks from the date of the notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination.

Limerick City & County Council has carried out an Appropriate Assessment (AA) Screening Report and has determined that a full Appropriate Assessment is not required in respect of this proposed development.
