## **Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Screening Certificate**

## N69 MUNGRET & BOLAND'S CROSS ROAD SAFETY IMPROVEMENT SCHEME

An EIA Screening Report has been prepared by Clandillon Civil Consulting, on behalf of Limerick City and County Council, in respect of the proposed N69 Mungret & Boland's Cross Road Safety Improvement Scheme.

This screening exercise was undertaken in two stages. The first stage considered the requirement for a mandatory EIAR, while the second stage considered the requirement or need for a sub-threshold EIAR. As part of the subthreshold screening exercise, the potential for impacts on environmental receptors were considered in addition to the interrelationship between those environmental receptors. Following on from this, the EIA Screening exercise was completed, in accordance with the criteria set out in the EIA Directive (2014/52/EU).

This EIA Screening Report concludes that this is a sub-threshold project which is not likely to have a significant effect on the environment, either by itself or in combination with other plans or projects and that an EIAR is not required.
