








5. The purpose of Adare FRS is to protect existing residential and commercial properties in Adare Village. Options for proposed defences are constrained by the locations of existing defences, residential and commercial properties, transport infrastructure (N21 and rail), Adare's impressive Heritage, and a wide range of environmental factors. In many instances, options are limited to a narrow range of technically viable solutions. At the two particular locations highlighted below, a wider range of options are available. Details of the options are presented on the project website <a href="www.adarefrs.ie">www.adarefrs.ie</a>. We would appreciate if you could provide your views on these options in the boxes provided below.



L1423: Station Road (L1423) will also require defences at Turf Quay and the rail crossing. Options under consideration here include flood defence at Turf Quay, road raising, realignment of defences, and use of temporary (demountable) defences when flood risk is high. One option under consideration would facilitate further development of Turf Quay as an amenity area. Five options are presented for your consideration on the posters at the Public Consultation Day. These posters are also available to view on the project website. Let us know what you think in the box below.









<b>Public Realm:</b> On delivery, the flood relief scheme would represent a significant investment in Adare Village. The value of this investment could be increased in combination with the Adare Public Realm Project.
