A Summary of the Appropriate Assessment Screening Report & Ecological Impact Assessment Report

For

The Development of an Existing Industrial Site as a Fire Service Training Centre at Kilmallock Business Park, Kilmallock, Co. Limerick.

An Appropriate Assessment Screening report and Ecological Impact Assessment Report were compiled on 25th June 2020 for Limerick City and County Council for the proposed Development of an Existing Industrial Site as a Fire Service Training Centre at Kilmallock Business Park, Kilmallock, Co. Limerick.

Screening for Appropriate Assessment determined that the project site is not within any designated site and the development has no hydrological connection with any of the SACs within 15km and so no impact on the Natura 2000 network is likely. Therefore, no further stages of Appropriate Assessment were required. An Ecological Impact Assessment was carried out as a precautionary measure to protect the nearby River Loobagh and local ecology.

Due to the small scale, nature of the project the need for an Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIAR) is not required.
