DRAFT ROAD TRAFFIC SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT BYE-LAWS - Speed Limit Appeals 2023 Incorporating Holycross to Lough Gur.

Limerick City and County Council has, in exercise of its powers under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 (no.44 of 2004); as amended by Section 86 of the Road Traffic Act 2010 and having consulted with An Garda Síochána, hereby gives notice of its intention to make Speed Limit Bye-Laws in respect of the area comprising the administrative area of the County of Limerick. Following on from a number of Speed Limit Appeals as per the Department of Transport Speed Limits Appeals Procedure and an amendment to the Holycross to Lough Gur Road the purpose of these Bye-Laws is to provide adjustments for speed limits at the following locations:

- a) Old Cork Rd
- b) Kilmallock
- c) Ardpatrick
- d) Holycross
- e) Bruff
- f) Knocknasna
- g) Caherelly
- h) Knocklong
- i) Kilfinane
- j) Holycross to Lough Gur
