Road Traffic Special Speed Limit Bye-Laws – Speed Limit Appeals 2023 Incorporating Holycross to Lough Gur

Limerick City and County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 9 of the Road Traffic Act, 2004 (No. 44 of 2004), hereby makes the following bye-laws in respect of the area comprising the administrative area of the County of Limerick.

The maps annexed to these bye-laws are for illustrative purposes only and in the event of a conflict between the maps and the text of the Schedule hereto, the text of the Schedule shall take precedence.

1. These Bye-Laws may be cited as the Limerick City and County Council Road Traffic Special Speed Limit Bye-Laws 2023 incorporating Holycross to Lough Gur
2. These Bye-Laws shall come into operation on the *****.
3. In these Bye-Laws:
 - “the Act of 2004” means the Road Traffic Act, 2004 (No. 44 of 2004);
 - “local road” has the meaning assigned to it by the Act of 1993;
 - “regional road” has the meaning assigned to it by the Act of 1993;
 - “road” means a public road and includes a motorway.
4. The provisions of the Limerick City & County Council County Limerick Road Traffic Special Speed Limit Byelaws 2019 for National, Regional & Local Roads, insofar as they apply to any of the roads or part thereof referred to in the below text of these Bye-Laws are hereby amended insofar as they relate to the said roads or part thereof with effect from the date on which these bye-laws come into effect.

FIRST SCHEDULE – 30kph PERIODIC SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT

Roads in respect of which a periodic special speed limit of 30 kilometres per hour is prescribed for the days Monday to Friday during school terms for the following periods;

- a) *Mornings Drop-off*: Start – 30 minutes before school starting time.
- b) *Mornings Drop-off*: End – at school starting time.
- c) *Early Collection*: Start – 5 minutes before collection time.
- d) *Early Collection*: End – 15 minutes after collection time.
- e) *Late Collection*: Start – 5 minutes before collection time.
- f) *Late Collection*: End – 15 minutes after collection time.

1) The following roads at Ardpatrick

- a) The Kilfinane Road L-1532 from a point 340m north east of its junction with the L-1570 to a point on the Kilfinane Road L-1532 462m north east of its junction with the L-1570

SECOND SCHEDULE – 50kph PERIODIC SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT

Roads in respect of which a periodic special speed limit of 50 kilometres per hour is prescribed for the days Monday to Friday during school terms for the following periods;

- a) *Mornings Drop-off*: Start – 30 minutes before school starting time.
- b) *Mornings Drop-off*: End – at school starting time.
- c) *Early Collection*: Start – 5 minutes before collection time.
- d) *Early Collection*: End – 15 minutes after collection time.
- e) *Late Collection*: Start – 5 minutes before collection time.
- f) *Late Collection*: End – 15 minutes after collection time.

1) The following roads at Caherelly

- a) The Ballyneety Road L-5087 from a point 110m north of its junction with the Grange Road L-5088 to a point on the Ballyneety Road L-5087 305m north of its junction with the Grange Road L-5087

2) The following roads at Knocknasna

- a) The Duagh Road L-7068 from a point 385m west of its junction with the L-7069 to a point on the Duagh Road L-7068 598m east of its junction with the L-7069

THIRD SCHEDULE – 50kph SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT

Roads in respect of which a special speed limit of 50 kilometres per hour is prescribed;

1. The following roads at Holycross/Lough Gur

- a) The Lough Gur Road L-1500 from its junction with the Limerick to Kilmallock Road R-512 to its Junction with the Herbertstown Road L-5062
- b) The Lough Gur Road L-8664 from its junction with the Herbertstown Road L-5062 to its junction with the Lough Gur Road L-86641
- c) the Lough Gur Road L-86641 from its junction with the Ballybricken Road L-8664 to a point 190m west of its junction with the Ballybricken Road L-8664

2. The following roads at Knocklong:

All roads in the area enclosed by a line commencing at a point on the R-513 Hospital Road, 236 metres north of its junction with the R-515 Elton Road and drawn thence in straight lines successively to the following points:-

- a) a point on the R-515 Emily Road, 309 metres east of its junction with the R-513 Hospital Road,
- b) a point on the R-513 Ballylanders Road, 573 metres southeast of its junction with the R-515 Emily Road,
- c) a point on the L-8521, 18 metres east from its junction with the L-8636 Road,
- d) a point on the L-8520, 17 metres south from its junction with the L-8521 Road,
- e) a point on the L-8518, 392 metres west from its junction with the L-8520 Road,
- f) a point on the R-515 Elton Road, 276 metres west from its junction with the R-513 Hospital Road,

and from the last mentioned point in a straight line to the commencement point on the R-513 Hospital Road.

Except those roads specified in the first schedule of County Limerick Road Traffic Special Speed Limit Byelaws 2019 For National, Regional Roads that are located within the area enclosed by the boundary line defining the 50kph special speed limit at Knocklong.

3. The following within the Limerick City and its Environs:

All local roads in the area enclosed by a line commencing at a point on the R-445 Limerick to Nenagh Road at its junction with L-1111 at St. Vincent's and drawn thence in straight lines successively to the following points:-

- a) the most southerly point on the L-11211 cul de sac,
- b) a point at the junction of the L-1121/L-5122 Roads (Killonan),
- c) a point at the junction of the L-1171 Road and the Limerick to Waterford National Primary Road N-24,
- d) a point on the Commons Road L-1170, 113m south of its junction with the L-1171 Road,
- e) a point on the Bohercoyle Road L-5138, 40m north east of its junction with the Old Cork Road R-512,
- f) a point on the Old Cork Road R512, 306 metres north-east of its junction with the Bohercoyle Road L-5138,
- g) a point on the Donoughmore Road L5109, 36m west of its junction with the Old Cork Road R512,

and drawn thenceforth along the south eastern edge of the following roads:-

- h) the Donoughmore Road L5109 to a point for a distance of 1220 metres,
and drawn thenceforth successively to the following points;
- i) a point on the Fedamore Road R-511, 280 metres south of its junction with the Donoughmore Road L-5109,
- j) a point on the Mill Rd L-5144, at its Junction with the Fedamore Road R-511,
- k) the most southerly point on the Euroville Cul de Sac L-51441,
- l) a point on Upper Church Road L-1405, 648 metres south east of its junction with the L-1443 Road,
- m) a point on St. Nessian's Road R-526, 600 metres south-west of its junction with Upper Church Road L-1405,
- n) the most south westerly point of the Mungret Graveyard Road L-51001,
- o) the most south westerly point of the L-51003 Road,
- p) the most north westerly point of the Ard Aulin Estate, Skehacreggaun,
- q) a point on the Ballykeeffe Boreen L-1441, at its junction with the R-510 Dock Road,
and drawn henceforth along the south eastern edge of the following roads:-

- r) the Dock Road R510 for a distance of 732m in a north easterly direction from its junction with the Ballykeeffe Boreen L1441,

and drawn henceforth in straight lines successively to the following points:-

- s) a point at the end of the cul de sac L-14301 at Coonagh West,
t) a point at the end of the cul de sac L-14302 at Coonagh East,
u) a point at the end of the cul de sac L-18001 at Clondrinagh Industrial Estate,
v) a point 30m east of the Limerick/Clare County Boundary on the Old Cratloe Road L-8078,
w) a point on the Pass Road L-8079, at its intersection with the Limerick/Clare County Boundary,
x) a point on the Knockalisheen Road L-8080 at its intersection with the Limerick/Clare County Boundary,
y) a point on the Long Pavement Road R-464 at its intersection with the Limerick/Clare County Boundary,
z) the most northerly point of the Mill Road L-10151,
aa) a point at the end of the cul de sac at No's 51 & 52 Silverbrook,
bb) a point at the end of the cul de sac at No's 70 & 71 Silverbrook,
cc) a point at the end of the cul de sac at No's 80 & 81 Silverbrook,
dd) a point on the Corbally Road R-463 at its intersection with the Limerick/Clare County Boundary,
ee) the most easterly point in the Cois Abhainn Estate ,
ff) the most northerly point in the Carabullawn Estate,
gg) the most north easterly point of No 44, Anglers Walk,
hh) the most westerly point of College Court Estate,
ii) the most northerly point of College Court Estate,
jj) the most north easterly point of the Plassey Park Road L-1118,
kk) a point at the intersection of the L-70003 Road and the L-70004 Road at Mulcair Drive,
and from the last mentioned point in a straight line to the commencement point on the R445 Limerick to Nenagh Road.

Except those roads specified in the first schedule in the County Limerick Road Traffic Special Speed Limit Byelaws 2019 For National, Regional & Local Roads, Limerick City and County Council Road Traffic(30 kilometres per hour Special Speed Limit) Bye-laws 2020, Limerick City and County Council Road Traffic(30 kilometres per hour Special Speed Limit) Bye-laws 2021, Limerick City and County Council Road Traffic(30 kilometres per hour Special Speed

Limit) Bye-laws 2022, Limerick City and County Council Road Traffic(30 kilometres per hour Special Speed Limit) Bye-laws 2023 that are located within the area enclosed by the boundary line defining the 50kph special speed limit within Limerick City and its Environs.

FOURTH SCHEDULE – 60kph SPECIAL SPEED LIMIT

Roads in respect of which a special speed limit of 60 kilometres per hour is prescribed;

1) The following roads at Ardpatrick

- a) The Kilfinane Road L-1532 from a point 462m north east of its junction with the L-1570 to a point on the Kilfinane Road L-1532 529m north east of its junction with the L-1570

2) The following roads at Bruff

- a) The Ballinlee Road L-51217 from its junction with the Kilmallock Road R-512 to point 2122m west of its junction with the Kilmallock Road R-512.

3) The following roads at Holycross

- a) The Limerick to Kilmallock Road R-512 from a point 190m north of its junction with the Lough Gur Road L-1500 to a point 500m south of its junction with the Knockainey Road L-1502.
b) The Knockainey Road L-1502 from its junction with the Limerick to Kilmallock Road R-512 to a point 265m southwest of its junction with the Limerick to Kilmallock Road R-512.

4) The following roads at Kilfinane

- a) The L-8561 from a point 366m north west of its junction with the L-1511 to a point 748m north west of its junction with the L-1511.

5) The following roads at Kilmallock

- a) The Ardpatrick Road R-512 from a point 492m south east of its junction with the Elton Road R-515 to a point 1330m south east of its junction with the Elton Road R-515.

6) The following roads at the Old Cork Road

- a) The Old Cork Road R-512, from a point 306m north west of its junction with the Boherkyle Road L-5138 to a point 100 metres south-east of its junction with Donoughmore Cross Roads L-5109/L-5107
